## URBAN MOBILITY INDIA

The Urban Mobility India (UMI) Conference and Expo is an annual flagship event held under the aegis of the Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, Government of India. The genesis of UMI is from the National Urban Transport Policy, 2006 of the Government of India, which lays a very strong emphasis on building capabilities at the State and city level to address the problems associated with urban transport and undertakes the task of developing sustainable urban transport systems. The event essentially has three components as below:

### Conference

The primary objective of the conference is to disseminate information to the cities, and to help them updating with the best urban transport practices. It provides an opportunity for key decision makers and delegates to interact with other professionals, experts, academia, industry, civil society, technology, service providers and other stake holders in Urban Transport both domestic and international so that the delegates can carry home ideas to develop their urban transport along a sustainable path. It is also a forum to discuss key issues relevant to the sector and suggest measures to address them. Awards for excellence / best practice projects in Urban Transport in 12 different categories are given during this conference.

### Exhibition

The expo is a special feature of UMI to disseminate and showcase the latest developments in urban transport technology and systems, implementation of best transport projects, propagation of innovative ideas, presentation of research in the topical areas of interest in urban transport and exchange of good urban transport initiatives and practices in the field.

### Research Symposium

The symposium provides a platform to highlight the current research carried out by academia and research institutes in urban transport, especially by young researchers pursuing post-graduation or Ph.D. programs.

Till date fourteen events have been held successfully. The **15<sup>th</sup> Urban Mobility India (UMI) Conference and Expo will be held from 4th to 6th November, 2022 at the Hotel Grand Hyatt Bolgatty, Kochi. The theme of this year's conference is "Azadi@75: Sustainable AatmaNirbhar Urban Mobility"**. The event will be organized by the Institute of Urban Transport (India) in collaboration with Kochi Metro Rail Ltd.
